DESCRIPTION

JICA conducted “the Study for Establishment of the Electric Power Technical Standards and Guideline in the Kingdom of Cambodia” from June 2002 to February 2004. In this study, the General Requirements of Electric Power Technical Standard (GREPTS) was prepared. Then GREPTS was promulgated as a ministerial regulation in July 2004. It was imperative for EAC, as the regulatory agency, to improve itself and prepare specific requirements for the standard so that GREPTS would be widely followed by power business enterprises. Under such circumstances, JICA conducted “the Technical Assistance Project for Capacity and

Institutional Building of the Electric Power Sector in Cambodia” through the period from September 2004 to September 2007. In the Project, the draft Specific Requirements of Electric Power Technical Standards (SREPTS) for Thermal Power Generating Facilities and Transmission and Distribution Facilities were prepared as they were important and required urgently at that time. Then, during the period from 2008 to 2009, JICA conducted “The Follow-up Study on the Establishment of the Specific Requirements for Electric Power Technical Standards (SREPTS) on Hydropower in order to contribute to the development of hydropower plants which is to be promoted in the country.
