DESCRIPTION

Turkey has a population of 73 million and is the number-one developing country in Middle East. GDP growth rate in 2010 was 8.9% in reflections of the rapid population growth and the strong increase in domestic demand in recent years.

The growth in economy and the increase of energy demand pose a risk for the energy security of Turkey's government.

The energy import ratio becomes 73% in 2010, and Energy Efficiency Improvement and Conservation becomes an important pillar of the energy policy. To correspond to this situation in Turkey, 'the Data Collecting Survey on Efficient Energy Management of the Public Building in Turkey' was conducted from 2011-2013 under the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA).
