DESCRIPTION

Nagano Hydropower Project is the principal project of the Kuzuryu River Development Scheme, and it is located 110km from the Nagoya industrial belt,

and 200km from the Osaka industrial belt. Large-scale oil-fired thermal power plants were constructed in the 1950's and 1960's for the power demand in the industrial areas. In order to run the thermal plants economically, the Nagano Power Plant was constructed as pumped storage power plant with an installed capacity of 220MW.
