DESCRIPTION

The Tagokura Hydroelectric Power Project is the main project of the Tadami River Development Scheme, together with the Okutadami Project (360MW).

The project is located on the upper part of the river, and was completed in 1959 by EPDC.

The Tagokura Dam is the largest concrete gravity dam in Japan with a concrete volume of 1,949,500m³. The installed capacity is 380MW, which is the largest of all the hydroelectric power projects in Japan other than pumped storage power projects.
