DESCRIPTION

The Nam Ngao Project, located upstream of the Mae Lama Luang Project, was identified in the "Master Plan Study of Nam Yuam River Basin"; and a

feasibility study of the project was conducted as an integrated development plan with the Mae Lama Luang Project.

The Nam Yuam River, a tributary of the Salween River which flows along the border between Thailand and Myanmar, is one of the remaining possible hydroelectric power resources in Thailand.
