

Kuzumaki No.2 Windfarm Commenced Commercial Operation

Commencement of commercial operation of 25th windfarm in Japan

Electric Power Development Co., Ltd. (hereafter “J-POWER”) announces that its project company (wholly owned subsidiary of J-POWER) has completed the construction works of Kuzumaki No.2 Windfarm and achieved commercial operation on December 10, 2020.

This windfarm had been under construction from June 2017 as the 2nd windfarm in Iwate prefecture, 25th in Japan for J-POWER.

J-POWER’s current owned capacity for wind power in operation in Japan totals 575,160kW including 44,600kW of Kuzumaki No.2 Windfarm. Adding 41,532kW of one windfarm under construction in Japan and 214,250kW of one offshore windfarm under construction overseas, J-POWER’s global owned capacity for wind power amounts 830,942kW.

J-POWER continues to promote developing renewable energy including wind power in Japan and overseas utilizing its knowledge and experience.
